INTRODUCTION

Carers are people who care for a relative, friend or neighbour who cannot manage at home without help because of illness, disability, or the effects of old age.

Carers can be any age, men or women, and the care they provide can vary between providing occasional help to fulltime support. Carers are ordinary people who simply get on with what has to be done when someone close to them needs help. Caring can be stressful and tiring and some people do it for many years, often unaware of the help that is available to them. - FREE Parking at the Royal Devon Hospital. Show your Alert card to the hospital department you are visiting and they will call car parking.
- 20% discount on non-branded food and drink in the restaurant and café.
- Many attractions across Devon offer discounts for carers and recognise the Alert card as proof of being a carer. Contact the venue in advance to check the arrangements.

The National Trust and English Heritage gives free entry to companions or carers of disabled visitors. For NT it is also possible to apply in advance for an 'Access for All Admit One Card'.

Sidmouth Library: reduced daily overdue charges, free loan of audio books and music CDs and reduced reservation charges. Similar concessions are also available to those with a disability.
